The impetus of this newsletter is to notify you about an upcoming in-person event. There is a project to redesign portions of **Tilden Way**. It involves a road diet (losing some lanes in the vicinity,) a new roundabout, safety improvements, new bicycle and pedestrian accommodations, changes to Pearl St at Fernside, etc.
